## STUDENT'S FEEDBACK ANALYSIS & ACTION TAKEN REPORT




Student's feedback was taken from 576 nos. of students consisting 441 from Arts Stream and 135 from commerce Stream. The feedback was collected through a structured questionnaire of 4 point scale ranging from strongly agree to strongly disagree. The questionnaire consists of various parameters such as classroom lecture deliver, course cover, allotment of project works & assignments, teaching aids including ICT, mentoring system, remedial classes, college library, physical and infrastructural facilities, programme on career guidance and career counselling, departmental seminar, workshop etc. All together 123 (thirteen) close ended statements were included in the questionnaire.



## 2. Class lecture delivered by the teachers of the subject concerned is clear, articulate & encouraging.





#### 4. Assignments are provided by the concerned teachers time to time.





#### 6. Project works are provided by the teachers as and when required.





## 3. The college library has sufficient no. of text and reference books, journals, newspapers, magazines etc.





## 10. Departmental & inter-departmental seminars, workshop and lecture programmes are conducted time to time.





## 12. Various Programmes on career guidance & counselling are conducted time to time on the topic relevant to the present day context.



- iii) Communicated the college authority to improve ICT facilities within the college campus.


## TEACHER'S FEEDBACK ANALYSIS & ACTION TAKEN REPORT



Teacher's feedback was collected from 49 nos. of faculties including Arts, Commerce and B. Voc. The feedback was collected through a structured questionnaire of 4 point scale ranging from strongly agree to strongly disagree. Questionnaire for teacher's feedback consists of parameters such as relevancy of the syllabus, course content of the syllabus, programme outcomes and course outcomes, credit allocation, teaching learning resources, academic flexibility, use of ICT, physical and infrastructural facilities, working of IQAC, transparency of internal assessment, College library, Greenery of College. All together 16 (sixteen) close ended statements were included in the questionnaire.

#### **TEACHER'S FEEDBACK ANALYSIS**


1) The current syllabus is need based and relevant to the present day context.




## 2) The course content stated in the syllabus maintains a balance between theoretical and practical component.






### 4) The allocation of the credits to the courses is appropriate in relation to the level of course.



Out of 49 respondents, 100% (49) of the respondents strongly agreed that the allocation of the credits to the courses is appropriate in relation to the level of course.


#### 5) The current syllabus needs revision.






Out of 49 respondents, 100% (49) of the respondents strongly agreed that the current syllabus needs revision.


#### 7) Curriculum has good academic flexibility.


#### 8) Authority of the college encourages the teachers to use ICT in their classes.







All the respondents i.e., 100% (49) strongly agreed that the internal assessment takes place as per the academic calendar of the College.


#### 10) Physical and infrastructural facilities including classrooms and others are adequate.




#### 11) College library facilities are adequate to serve the needs of teachers and students.






#### 13) New methods of teachings are encouraged by the authority.



All the respondents i.e., 100% (49) strongly agreed that the new methods of teachings are encouraged by the authority.




#### 14) The IQAC is working well for promoting quality in the College.








#### ANALYSIS OF ALUMNI FEEDBACK FOR THE SESSION: 2021-2022

Alumni's feedback was taken from 72 nos. of alumni on a structured questionnaire of 4 point scale ranging from strongly agree to strongly disagree.


#### **ANALYSIS:**

100% (i.e. 72) of the alumni strongly agreed that they feel proud to be the student of Kharupetia College.


#### 2) The learning I had in the college is useful in my career



79% (57) of the alumni agreed that the learning they had in the college was very much useful in their career which was followed by 21% (15) agreed on the same.




## 3) Development activities organized by the college for my overall development are helpful




75% (54) of the alumni strongly agreed that the activities organized by the college for their overall development was helpful and 25% (18) agreed on the same.

It is found that 95% (68) of alumni strongly agreed in case of satisfaction about the college campus environment while 5% (5) agreed on the same.


#### 5) The Grievances are properly handled at the college




#### 6) Adequacy of faculties needed for students during my tenure




In case of availability of facilities for the students in the college, 87% (63) of the alumni were satisfied during their tenure while 13% (9) agreed on the same.

#### 7) The developments in the college in the recent years are appreciative




75% (54) of alumni appreciated the recent developmental activities of the college while 25% (18) viewed the same.

#### 8) The college is involving Alumni in its activities




91% (66) alumni agreed that the college is providing opportunities to participate in the various socio-cultural activities of the college from time to time while 9% (6) viewed the same.
